Do you know someone who is stubborn? Stubbornness always gets a bad rap, but it can be a good thing or a bad thing.

Stubbornness is a good thing when it's unwilling to yield to the things of the world, but it is bad when it's unwilling to yield to the things of God. Ungodly stubbornness is the result of pride.
