To “look after,” “visit,” “care for” – are phrases that are found throughout scripture referring to the coming of God to deliver His people from crisis (Genesis 21:1; 50:24; Exodus 3:16; 4:31; Luke 1:68; 78; Acts 15:14).

Repeatedly throughout scripture, God calls His people to care for orphans, widows, and sojourners (Isaiah 1:17; Deuteronomy 27:19; Zechariah 7:9-10; Psalm 82:3).
