However, many in our churches today find themselves spiritually dry and relationally divided. There is a great need for renewal in both the personal and relational dimensions of our spiritual lives.

In our text, God led Ezekiel the prophet to a valley of dead bones to witness a miraculous revival by a mighty movement of God's Spirit.
