As people of faith, Jesus should always be our first love and our true north. We should passionately walk in His will and live for His glory.

We may go through seasons of spiritual drought. However, spiritual renewal can be experienced in personal worship (Ps. 119:162-165).

In our text, Isaiah the prophet experienced a remarkable renewal of his heart to God as he drew near to the Lord in personal worship.
